ABOUT EBID

The ECOWAS Bank for Investment and Development (EBID) is the development finance institution of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS).

The Bank was established on 28th May 1975 as the Fund for Cooperation, Compensation and Development of the ECOWAS (ECOWAS Fund), on the same date as the erstwhile Executive Secretariat of the ECOWAS (the present ECOWAS Commission).

The Bank, which is headquartered in Lomé, in the Togolese Republic, started operations in 1979. In 1999, the ECOWAS Fund was transformed into the EBID Group with two subsidiaries. However, in 2006, the ECOWAS Authority of Heads of State and Government agreed to reorganise the EBID Group into one unified entity with two windows: one for promoting the private sector and the other, for developing the public sector in order to extend the services of the Bank to a wider range of stakeholders involved in sustainable economic development activities and programmes at national and regional levels.

EBID has been operating under this new structure since January 2007.

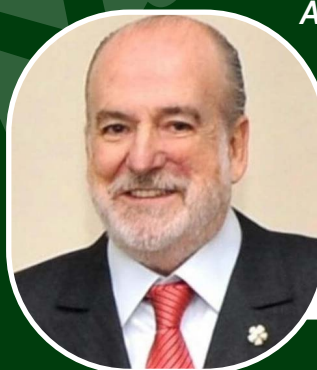
